All cats & dogs are neutered/spayed and up to date on vaccines.

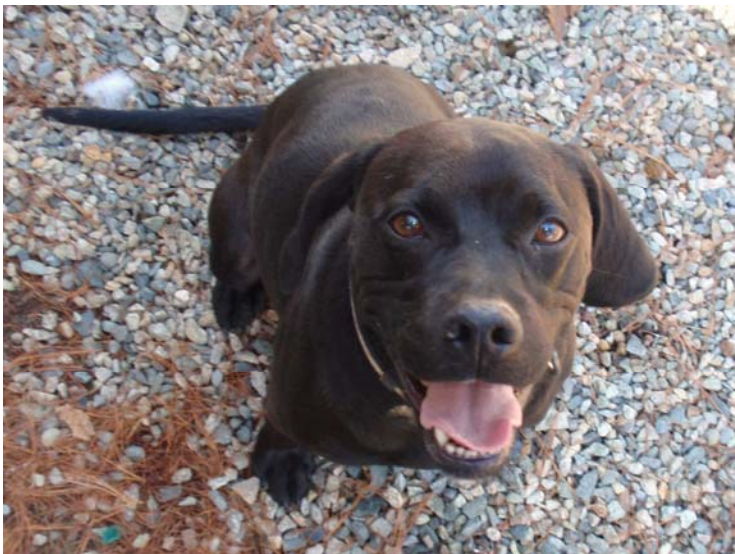

SISSY



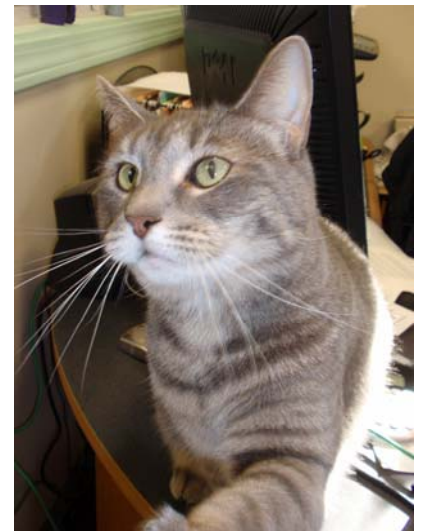
